Rules of Competition

All dancing rules governed by the SOBHD.

- 1. Classes will be divided according to the number of entries received. The MWHDA reserves the right to combine, cancel, or divide an event.
- 2. Dancers will compete in inverse order of entries received. <u>Please note registrations will not be entered until a valid Scotdance number is provided as per Scotdance Canada rules</u>. Scotdance cards with valid 2014 stamp must be presented at the time competitors pick up their numbers.
- 3. Competitors will dance in their respective age groups.
- 4. Competitors must be on hand when their event is called or forfeit their entry.
- 5. Competitors must dance to the pipers and swords provided by the MWHDA.
- 6. Competition secretary must be notified as soon as possible of any changes in classification.
- 7. All judges decisions are final.
- 8. Any protest must be made in writing to the competition secretary at the event accompanied by a \$20 fee (refundable if sustained).
- 9. Competitors must remain in full costume and must present their Scotdance cards to receive medals or awards. If cards are not presented a fee of \$10 will be levied and medals will be released upon presentation of card.
- 10. Marshals and competitors only in the marshalling areas.
- 11. Dancers and their guardians only in the change rooms (female, male, unisex (for dancers with opposite sex parent)).
- 12. NSF cheques will be charged a fee of \$35. Entry deadline September 15, 2011.
- 13. Medals will be awarded in pre-premier. Premier classes all receive cash awards.
- 14. Special hornpipe events do not count toward totals for aggregate trophies.
- 16. Dancers must be appropriately clothed in public areas at all times as per Scotdance Canada rules. Shirts or jackets are mandatory. Changing in change rooms only. Those not complying will be asked to
