

COMPETITION RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1) Closing date for entries is FRIDAY, JANUARY 15th, 2016. To be accepted, entries postmarked after the closing date must include an additional \$25 late fee.
- 2) Entries will be accepted by POST ONLY and dancers will compete in reverse order of entry (first entry competes last). No refunds shall be issued for entries received.
- 3) If a change of category is required after your entry is sent out, please contact excaliburarts@shaw.ca.
- 4) Competitor's age as of Jan 30th, 2016 determines the class entered for competition.
- 5) Dancing will commence at 9am. Registration starts at 8am. Please pick up your number at the registration table.
- 6) The competition committee reserves the right to combine, cancel, or divide events.
- 7) Any dancer causing delay will forfeit entry in that dance.
- 8) Competition will run under the Scottish Official Board of Highland Dance.
- 9) Judge's decisions are final.
- 10) Dancers must present SOBHD registration card prior to receiving awards. All dancers must include registration number on entry form.
- 11) Dance classes will be split at close of entries.
- 12) It is the responsibility of competitors to pick up prizes at the competition. Prizes not claimed on or before February 15, 2016 will be forfeited.
- 13) Complaints must be written, signed and submitted by the end of the competition day, accompanied by a \$25 fee.
